



Doodling on Fabric



Supplies

- Fabric
- Freezer Paper
- Sakura Metallic Pens
- Sakura Stardust Pens
- Embroidery Floss
- Scissors
- Needle
- Button
- Cardstock
- Patterned Paper

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Iron the shiny side of the freezer paper to the wrong side of the fabric. Trim the fabric to fit the freezer paper.
2. Use Sakura Metallic Pens and Stardust Pens to doodle on the fabric.
3. Cut the fabric into strips and remove the freezer paper.
4. Fold the fabric strip in half and use embroidery floss to stitch down the unfinished side. Use a running stitch.
5. Pull the stitches tight to create the flower shape.
6. Tie a knot on the back of your flower. Add a button the center if you wish.
7. Cut a piece of yellow cardstock 10x7 and fold in half. Adhere patterned paper (cut into a wave pattern) to the front of the card. This is the card base.
8. Use Fabri Tac to adhere the flowers to the front of the card base. Add leaves if desired.
