

## Doodling on Fabric



## Supplies

- Fabric
- Freezer Paper
- Sakura Metallic Pens
- Sakura Stardust Pens
- Embroidery Floss
- Scissors
- Needle
- Button
- cardstock
- · Patterned Paper

## 1. Iron the shiny side of the freezer paper to the wrong side of the fabric. Trim the fabric to fit the freezer paper.

- 2. Use Sakura Metallic Pens and Stardust Pens to doodle on the fabric.
- 3. Cut the fabric into strips and remove the freezer paper.
- 4. Fold the fabric strip in half and use embroidery floss to stitch down the unfinished side. Use a running stitch.
- 5. Pull the stitches tight to create the flower shape.
- 6. Tie a knot on the back of your flower. Add a button the center if you wish.
- 7. Cut a piece of yellow cardstock 10x7 and fold in half. Adhere patterned paper (cut into a wave pattern) to the front of the card. This is the card base.
- 8. Use Fabri Tac to adhere the flowers to the front of the card base. Add leaves if desired.
