


WRAPPING PAPER



SUPPLIES

- Upcycled Paper (shopping bag, packing paper)
- Sakura Permapaque - Black
- Koi Watercolors by Sakura
- Palette
- Paintbrush



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Grab any large piece of paper -- an old shopping bag, some paper that was used as stuffing in a box -- and using a black Permapaque marker, divide it into five sections, with a double line between each section.
2. In each of the five sections, doodle some simple designs: a flower, squares, circles. Doodling should be fun and no stress!
3. Using Koi Tube Watercolors, squeeze out the three primary colors: yellow, blue, and red, onto a palette.
4. Use the yellow and red paint to color in your doodles. You don't have to color in the whole area. Use the color as an accent!
5. Use the blue paint to draw a dashed line between each section, or make up your own design!
6. When you're finished you can use your paper to wrap packages or even as a replacement for patterned paper on a scrapbook layout!
