Papier Mache Angel



Materials needed

Frame. 11"x14" – Style of choice

Artist's Loft™ Canvas Board, 11"x14"

Liquitex® Gesso - White

Liquitex® Gel Medium

Liquitex® Soft Body Acrylic Paint – Burnt Umber

Darice® Paper Mache – Mannequin

Cheese Cloth

24ga Wire - Silver

Scrap Newspaper

Stylist

Scissors

Paintbrush

Paper Towels

Paper Palette

Low Heat Glue Gun

Instructions

- 1. Paint frame with white gesso, let dry.
- 2. Very lightly dry brush with burnt umber. Remember you can always add more color if desired.
- 3. Paint canvas with white gesso, let dry.
- 4. Add some torn pieces of newspaper to canvas using gel medium as glue.
- 5. Add second coat of gesso to canvas, while wet use stylist to write words as desired onto canvas, let dry.
- 6. Dry brush burnt umber onto canvas.
- 7. Paint mannequin with white gesso, let dry.
- 8. Use gel medium to add cheese cloth to mannequin draping as you go. Let dry.
- 9. Form wings with wire, add cheese cloth to wings using the gel medium as glue and let dry.
- 10. Glue wings to back of mannequin.
- 11. Glue manneguin to canvas.
- 12. Add to frame.
