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ZENTANGLE EARRINGS

SUPPLIES

- Sakura Pigma Micron Pen
- White Cardstock
- Earring Hooks
- Eyelets
- Hole Punch
- Eyelet Setter
- Pliers
- Matte Medium or Gel Medium
- Scissors
- Paintbrush

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Draw four dots on a piece of white cardstock. Connect the dots to create a rectangle or square.
- 2. Within the rectangle or square draw a loop or otherwise divide the space into smaller sections.
- 3. Within each section, doodle a pattern. If you're stuck for patterns please visit the following site for inspiration and free instructions: http://tanglepatterns.com/tag/zentangle
- 4. Cut the rectangle shape out and then cut it in half.
- Coat both sides of the paper with Matte Medium or Gel Medium to seal it and make it water resistant.
- 6. Using a hole punch and an eyelet setter, place an eyelet at the top of each rectangle.
- 7. Add your earring hooks and you're done!
