Customize and personalize a float glass frame quickly and easily with Painters®!



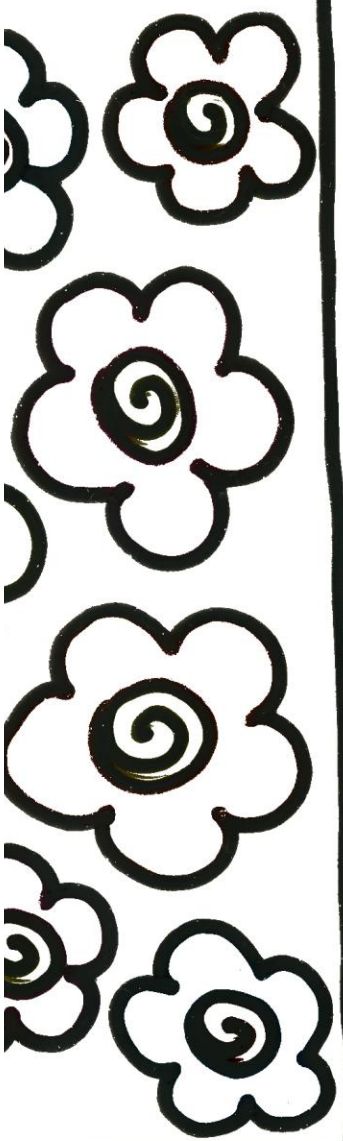
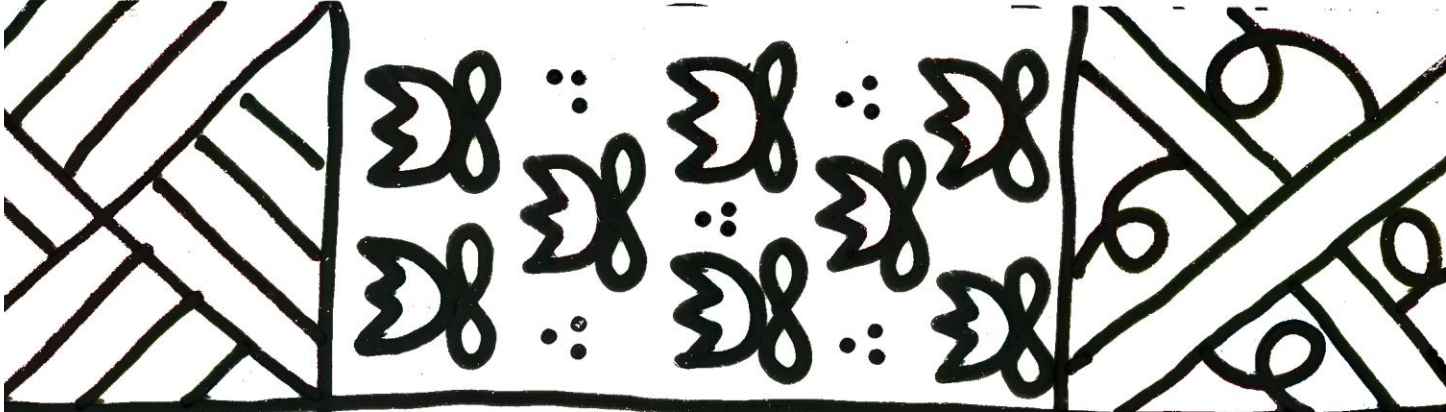
For this project you will need:

- Elmer's® Craftbond™ Glue Spots – Medium
- Painters® - Set of 5 Neon Colors plus Black (or your choice of colors)
- X-Acto® 12" Rotary Trimmer

8" x 10" Float Glass Frame
Photograph

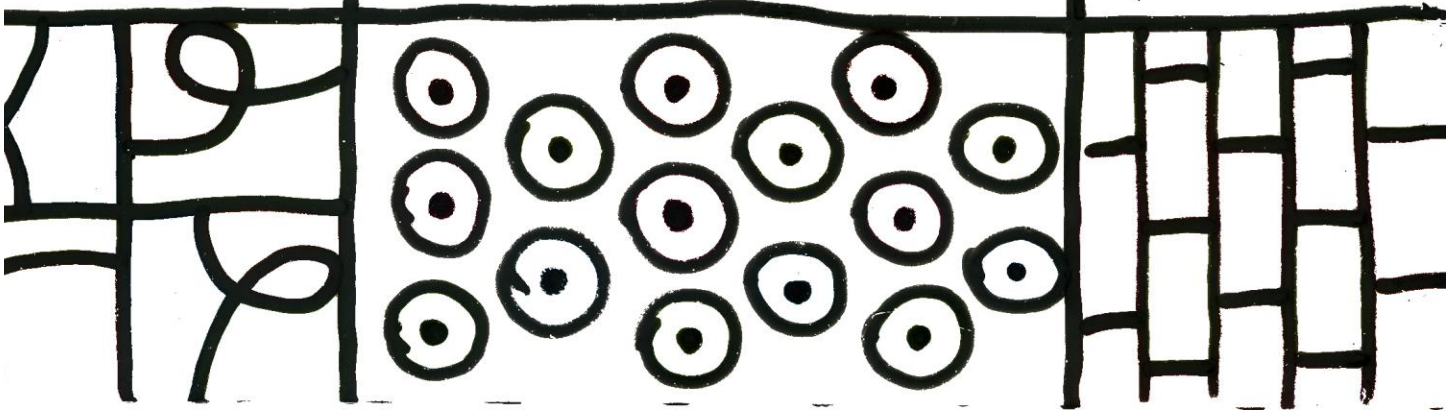
1. Place one piece of glass on top of the pattern. You can use the one given here, or create your own. Trace over the pattern with the Black Painter, or simply doodle around the area where the photograph will be.
2. Make sure the paint outline is dry then turn the glass over. Color in the patterns created with colored Painters on the black of the glass.
3. Adhere the photograph to the front of the second piece of glass with glue spot. Let the paint cure for about 24 hours then reassemble the glass frame. **TIP:** You can use any image, or pattern you like to decorate the glass frame. Simply place the glass on top then trace over it with a Painter marker.
