Funky Kaleidoscope Pendants

Supplies:

- Personal computer and printer
- <u>Kaleidoscope Collections</u> Kaleidoscope Kreator™ software
- Digital image (from digital camera or scanned)
- <u>Little Windows</u>[®] "Make 3 Kit" *
- Paper punches in the size and shape you want for your pendants

* Little Windows is a unique resin, which is non-toxic, low odor, low-bubbling, and stays crystal clear. It's perfect for in-home crafters!

Instructions:

- 1. Open the digital image in Kaleidoscope Kreator and create a kaleidoscope to your liking.
- 2. If you want to use the entire kaleidoscope for the pendant, size the kaleidoscope to be 0.1" smaller than the punch size and add a 0.2" print margin when printing the kaleidoscope. If you want to use just a portion of the kaleidoscope for the pendant, then print the kaleidoscope up to 2x the size of the paper punch.
- 3. When punching out the kaleidoscope, turn the paper punch upside down so that you can line up the printed kaleidoscope inside the punch opening.
- 4. Follow the instructions in the *Little Windows* "Make 3 Kit" to make the pendants.
