Julie McGuffee shares ideas for personalizing coffee mugs, cell phones, electronic tablets, key chains and other items.



Key Chain:

Suggestions: Holiday Greetings, Thank You, Photos, Names

Personalize your keychain with pictures, paper & stickers. Paper is included along with some letters.

Slide out tray from end opposite key ring. Remove sample and use a template to cut your photo or paper to size. Set finished paper on tray and slide tray back in.

Pen:

Suggestions: Holiday Greetings, Thank You, Photos, Names

Personalize your pen with pictures, papers, beads, needlework, fabric, rubberstamping and stickers. Paper is included along with some letters.

Unscrew black cap on top, slide off pocket clip clear cover and paper insert. Wrap your project up to 2-3/8"x1-3/4"x3/32" thick around pen. Slide clear cover over pen. Slide on pocket clip, screw on black cap.

Paper:

Using the Simplicity Cutter you can cut strips from ¹/₄" to 6" for layering paper.

Using the Simplicity Embosser, you can emboss your own 12"x12" scrapbook pages. Inking adds dimensions.

Tablet Case:



Suggestions: Pictures, Scrapbook Pages, Calendar, Holiday Greetings, Birthday Wishes.

Remove black frame. Finished paper will be 7"x9". Design a scrapbook page and personalize by adding stickers/embellishments to the border. Insert completed paper into mouse pad.

Phone Cover:



Personalize with pictures, messages, artwork, paper crafting 2-x4-1/4" paper. Take off frame and insert.

Cup:

Create your own background by personalizing with names, holiday greetings, artwork, pictures, create a scrapbook page or create on the computer. Use the original paper as a template – approximately 9"x7" with a small curve at the bottom. Embellish with stickers.

Unscrew top of mug. Remove black mug and insert your design and screw back together.
