Sakura Watercolor Layout



- Using a very wet paintbrush add lots of different colors of Sakura Koi Tube Watercolors to a sheet of watercolor paper. While the paint is still wet splash some colorful drops around so that all the colors meld and blend. Optional: You can spray the paper with water and blot with a paper towel to lighten the color.
- 2. Once the watercolor paper dries, draw a series of circles down one side with a

Sakura Permapaque Marker.

- 3. Fill the circles with red Sakura Koi Watercolor paint. Let dry.
- 4. Using a credit card or room key scrape a thin layer of gesso or white acrylic paint across the surface of the watercolor paper. This will tone down the bright colors of the watercolors.
- 5. Trim the watercolor paper down to 8.5"x11" and round the corners.
- 6. Adhere the watercolor paper and a

4"x6" photo to a sheet of black cardstock. Optional: Stitch around the edge of the watercolor paper and the photo.

7. Add alphabet stickers and journaling with a Sakura Pigma Micron .05 and you're done!
