

My Sister Has the Best Sister

Materials Needed:

Brother™ ScanNCut – colors and styles may vary by model
White Cardstock
Gesso
Gelatos
Modeling Paste
Stencil
Patterned Paper
Letter Stickers
Wood Veneers
Enamel Dots
Spray Mist
Needle and thread
Favorite photo

Instructions:

1. Cover White cardstock with clear Gesso and let dry completely.
2. Cut a circular heart pattern on the White cardstock, using the ScanNCut.
3. Leave all of the paper on your mat, and add Gelato colors to the hearts, smudging with your finger.
4. Don't worry that it's messy. You'll pull the paper up and have the heart shapes to work with later on.
5. Lay a stencil over the paper that is still on your mat, and layer Modeling Paste over the stencil to create texture on the heart shapes.
6. Once the Modeling Paste is completely dry, remove the negative cut part of the paper from the mat, leaving the heart shapes still in place.
7. Place the negative cut paper over the patterned paper you are using for your background.
8. Begin removing the individual hearts and adhering them in the coordinating places on the negative cut paper.
9. Once all of your hearts are adhered, remove the negative cut paper and your heart background will be perfectly placed with the positive heart shapes.
10. Machine stitch or hand stitch through the hearts.
11. Add a photo to the center of the hearts.
12. Use letter stickers to create your title.
13. Embellish with wood veneers and spray mist.
