# Easy No-Sew Fringe-Flowers

Create an easy and fun flower embellishment with fabric and felt that can decorate your home, scrapbook page, or hair!

### Supplies:

- Kunin® Eco-fiPlus Premiumfelt ™
- Fabric
- Fabric Adhesive
- Scissors
- Faber-Castell PITT pen.
- Optional brads, buttons, skewers, or hair clips

#### Instructions:

- 1. Cut multiple circles from fabric and felt with each layer graduating larger and ending with the largest circle being cut from fabric. It is recommended that each fabric circle layer should be 3-4 layers of fabric to give the fabric circle substance.
- **2.** Glue fabric layers together, keeping glue any ½ from edges of fabric.
- **3.** Glue 4-5 layers of graduating circles and allow to dry.
- **4.** Using scissors, snip from outside edge up to second circle layer (It's ok if you snip a bit of the second circle layer too).
- **5.** Embellish flower with faux stitching using PITT pen.
- **6.** Optional touches
  - o add a button or a brad to the center of your fringe-flower
  - o glue to hair clip or headband for great hair accessory
  - oglue a skewer between the last circle layers to create a

stem and make a flower arrangement
